Electricity market design issues in the Baltic Sea region

Integration of electricity markets in the Baltic Sea region have highlighted different regulatory approaches of electricity market design that have been applied in the countries. These discrepancies have created market distortions that influence operations of the markets and potential investment decisions. The first session aims to highlight some challenges that impose highest concerns to the countries. The representatives of the countries are asked to respond in 5 minutes to the following questions, followed by 5 minutes discussion to clarify the issues:

What 2-3 specific power market design challenges you would highlight in your country? How they influence competition in the power market? What would be an ideal solution for these issues?

Creation of gas market around the Baltic Sea

Gas market developments around the Baltic Sea are oftentimes contradictory and influenced by politics. Uncertainties about gas market have in number of countries led to the decrease of the use of gas in the region. The second session aims to discuss the issues that hinder the developments of the gas market in the region and tries to explore conditions for a positive development scenario. The representatives of the countries are asked to respond in 5 minutes to the following questions, followed by 5 minutes discussion to clarify the issues:

What 2-3 main regulations or other aspects are hindering gas market developments in your country? What gas infrastructure (interconnectors, LNG, etc) would boost Baltic Sea regional gas market? How these developments would impact power markets?
